Biography of John Domm, MOM, BAA, MA, CMMIII

John Domm is the Chief of Police for the Rama Police Service in Ontario with overall responsibility for operations, administration and corporate affairs. Rama hosts one of the three largest commercial casinos in the province and the only commercial site on First Nations territory. Prior to joining Rama in 2009, he served Nishnawbe-Aski Police Service as Deputy and Chief. He started his career with the Halton Regional Police Service and fulfilled nearly

17 years in various positions.

Chief Domm is currently serving as Past President of the First Nations Chiefs of Police Association and he sits on the Board of Directors for the Canadian Association of Chiefs of Police and the Canadian Police Knowledge Network. He further volunteers on the Board of Directors for Frontier College, Canada's original literacy organization. He is past Co-Chair of the national Coalition on Community Safety, Health and Well-Being and the Canadian Association of Chiefs of Police Crime Prevention Committee. Further, he served six years as a Director for the Ontario Association of Chiefs of Police.

Chief Domm holds a Bachelor of Applied Arts degree in justice studies and a Master of Arts degree in leadership from the University of Guelph. He's a graduate of the University of Toronto, Rotman School of Management Executive Program for police leadership and he holds many certificates from the Ontario and Canadian Police Colleges. He's been presented with the Member Order of Merit of the Police Forces, the Queens Diamond Jubilee Medal and the Police Exemplary Service Medal.
