Rick Angeconeb Lac Seul First Nation Police Service

Chief Rick Angeconeb has over 20 years of policing experience in his home community of Lac Seul First Nation. He works, lives, and enjoys engaging with his community in language of Ojibway, where he is a fluent speaker.

With early interest in policing, his older brother was the first Police Officer stationed at the Kejick Bay, Lac Seul First Nation. They worked out of the Band office and had minimal equipment, which included a duty belt and a police boat. There was eventually a log cabin built in the community without electricity, where the officer

stationed his detachment. The position was administered under the Ontario Provincial Police Special Constable Policing Program.

In 1995, Lac Seul Police Service signed a new policing agreement with Lac Seul First Nation, Canada, and Ontario; where they established the new Stand-alone Policing Agreement. Rick commenced duties after attending the Recruit Police Training Program, and eventually was promoted to Sergeant in 1998, and then to Chief of Police in 2004.

He's avidly enjoyed the years as a frontline officer and Shift Supervisor. He has been through many operational changes, including items such as reporting from paper writing, to Enterpol RMS and Niche. Many other changes took place which included the office workspace, and the addition of the Community Police Rooms. Courts are now held in the community, where previously, the community members had to leave the territory to appear in court.

Lac Seul Police Service continues to support community initiatives by engaging in the various youth activities, including Crime Prevention with field trips with educational components. Rick still enjoys policing and being interactive with the public and community members, by promoting Lac Seul Police Service and its members.
